STRENGTHENING SCHOOL MANAGEMENT AND ACCOUNTABILITY

1. The Ministry of Education is implementing various activities under the PRIEDE Project from a grant received from the Global Partnership for Education (GPE) under the supervision of the World Bank to support development of primary school education sub-sector in Kenya and intends to apply part of the grant proceeds to eligible payments of activities outlined in the Grant Agreement.
2. The Ministry of Education has disbursed the first tranche of KES **407,100,000 (Kenya Shillings Four Hundred and Seven Million, One hundred Thousand only)** to the first group of 1357 Schools in 27 Counties, out of the 4000 target schools in 47 Counties.
3. The disbursed funds are to finance implementation of identified priorities in the overall School Improvement Plan (SIP).
4. Each target school will receive a grant of US\$5000 in two tranches. The first tranche will be disbursed based on the school's categorization following the findings of the recent school based risk audit.
5. All Schools categorized as 'red', will be required to comply with the agreed upon fiduciary requirements for management and accountability of Government capitation grants to schools.
