The High Commission of Malaysia invites applications from eligible Kenyans to participate in various online courses offered under the Malaysian Technical Cooperation Programme as follows:

### Targeted participants and entry requirements

1. Must be citizens from among all recipient countries of MTCP.
2. Nominated by the Government of the respective countries
3. Had not participated in any course under MTCP.
4. Should possess a fairly good command of the English Language (both spoken and written abilities).
5. Should be at the age of under 45 years at the commencement of the course
6. Must have access to the computer (preferably with multiple screen) and reliable internet connection.
7. Education professionals who wish to take on the roles of trainers in extending impact within the context of designing online courses
8. Participants are expected to have basic ICT literacies

9. Fulfilling pre-requisite 1-week course before the commencement of the training

### **Rules and regulations**

1. Participants should conduct themselves at all times in a manner compatible with their responsibilities as MTCP participants and abide by the laws, rules and regulations as may be stipulated by the host Government in respect of this training course.
2. During online classes, participants are required to dress appropriately in office attire.
3. For formal occasions - lounge suit or national costume are welcomed.

4. All application forms must be duly completed and endorsed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs or National Focal/Aid Coordinator Agency in the countries and submitted ONLY through diplomatic channel via the Embassy/High Commission of Malaysia.
5. Only successful applicants will receive the official invitation notification One (1) week from the course date, by the Training Institute via email.
