CALL FOR APPLICATION: DAAD SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME “INCOUNTRY/ IN REGION” FOR SUB-SAHARA AFRICA FOR POSTGRADUATE COURSES (MASTERS AND PhD) INTAKE 2023/2024

The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) regional office in Nairobi has announced a new call for DAAD funded scholarship Programme “In-Country / In-Region” for Sub-Saharan Africa.

The Scholarships are available for Master and PhD courses at selected institutions in Benin, Cameroon, Ghana, Kenya, Malawi, Nigeria, Tanzania and Uganda for a wide range of disciplines, including:-

Public and Environmental Health, Geomatics, Engineering (Energy Technology, Metallurgical and Materials Engineering) Natural Sciences (Biostatistics, Biology, Bioinformatics, food chemistry, Parasitology and pharmacology) Agricultural Sciences, Mathematics and social Sciences.

The target group for this scholarship are graduates and postgraduates from sub-Saharan Africa with a First class academic degree if applying for Masters programme, or with a Master degree if applying for a Doctoral programme, and who want to pursue the courses in their home country (so called In-Country scholarships) or in another Sub-Saharan African Country (In-Region scholarships)

Female applicants and candidates from less privileged regions or groups are especially encouraged to participate in this programme!

The Scholarship benefits include, monthly individual scholarship payments, payment of tuition fees, research allowances, summer schools, research stays in Germany and skill trainings.

The deadline for application is **9th December 2022**.
